■ The Hall of Democracy Pavilion will house the Institute of War and Democracy. The facility will include a private research library, a 100-seat state-of-the-art media center / production studio, classrooms for educational outreach for distance learning, conference rooms, office spaces, a large special exhibition hall with special event entry through the Historic Firehouse. Most spaces are designed to be flexible in function allowing the Museum to utilize rooms for special exhibits and/or functions.

The exterior will be constructed of corrugated metal, precast concrete and aluminum composite panels with a glass curtainwall and cantilevered roof.
